The Northland 300 is a 300 mile, 3 day, charity snowmobile ride, made up of volunteer participants who raise funds to support Special Olympics Minnesota. The event will take place January 21-25, 2009. For the first time ever in the history of Special Olympics Minnesota and the Northland 300, an athlete and a coach will be participating in the Northland 300. They are excited! Special Olympic athlete Steven Eull and Coach Jason Reinsch, who is an MCE employee, have turned in their registrations, attended the 1st Driver/Support Meeting, and are out raising funds for a cause they truly believe in.

Steven Eull is a Special Olympic athlete who loves winter. He is very excited to be riding on the back of his coach's snowmobile to participate in the 2009 Northland 300. Steven was born with Down syndrome and has been involved in Special Olympics Minnesota since he was 8 years old. He is a member of the Area 12 Flames team which competes in softball, swimming, track &

field, bowling, golf, and downhill & slalom skiing. He is also part of the Athlete Leadership program where he has been trained to be a Global Messenger, speaking at public events.

Jason is a certified coach and has been coaching Steven for 11 years. Jason has wanted to participate in the Northland 300 for the past three years but has not found time in his busy schedule until this year. This will be a fun and exciting challenge for Jason.

This will truly be a historical moment for Special Olympics and the Northland 300.
