# FUNDRAISING... HELPFUL HINTS

Raising funds for Special Olympics is easy to do. Snowmobiling is great fun and when you put these two together it is a great ride to benefit a great cause. Great people do great things. Here are some ideas on how to make it happen...

## CASH OR CHECK DONATION

Ask a friend, neighbor, family member, your doctor, dentist, etc. if they would like to make a cash or check donation.

## SELL RAFFLE TICKETS

Raffle tickets are available to sell and each dollar raised goes toward your required donations. Tickets are \$5 each with a great bunch of prizes. Everyone has a chance to win. Ask people to help by selling a book for you.

## CORPORATE DONATION

Ask the company you work for if they would like to donate or ask companies that you do business with if they would like to help you in your support of a great cause by making a donation.

## COMPANY MATCHING FUNDS

Ask the company you work for if they have a Matching Funds Program. If so, they can help double or triple the amount of funds you have raised.

## COMPANY DONATION FOR EMPLOYEE VOLUNTEER HOURS

Ask the company you work for if they make donations based on the number of volunteer hours you contribute to a non-profit.
